

## IN MEMORIAM

**DR. VIJAY KUMAR VERMA**



(25.09.1965–10.07.2014)

We deeply regret that we have lost one of our dedicated teacher, noble friend and generous human being Dr. Vijay Kumar Verma in a fatal road accident on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2014.

He was born on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 1965 in a small village near Sarkaghat in Mandi District of Himachal Pradesh (India). After passing Matriculation with flying colours, he obtained the degree of Bachelor of Science in 1985, securing first position in the college. Subsequently, he obtained the degrees of Master of Science and Master of Philosophy in Mathematics from Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla both in first divisions. Recently, in the year 2013, he completed his Doctor of Philosophy from Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla under the guidance of Professor Joginder Singh Dhiman. A few of his research papers have been published in the international journals. He has also presented his scientific works in various conferences. His major area of research interest was hydrodynamic stability theory.

Dr. Vijay Kumar Verma started teaching voluntarily in Government College at Shimla, even when he was unemployed. He was appointed as a college lecturer in the Department of Higher Education, Government of Himachal

Pradesh, India in the year 1993 and served the department selflessly till his last breath.

Dr. Vijay Kumar was a dedicated teacher, an able administrator, a noble friend and sincere colleague. Throughout his life he worked for the welfare of society and particularly, for the upliftment of the poor by helping them through various means. He was a benevolent and generous human being. He was a founder member of *Sai Engineering Foundation*, Shimla and was actively associated with the charitable activities of the foundation. Apart from imparting free coaching to poor and needy students, he also donated blood for more than 25 times during his life time. Dr. Vijay contributed his best for the sustenance and prosperity of the Foundation without seeking any remuneration or reward and devoted his short life for the welfare of others.
